

Lifeguard

Lifeguards must be 16 years or older, have CPR/First Aid and Lifeguard

Certification. (training is NOT provided by the camp), demonstrate a professional demeanor and an excellent rapport with all families, work both independently and cooperatively with other staff members and above all to be punctual and prepared.

A lifeguard is expected to be a role model for all summer campers and pool patrons. Hours vary based on scheduling.

Job Responsibilities/Expectations include (but are not limited to)

- ☐ **Lifeguards are expected to maintain open, friendly and cooperative relationships with each child and family.**
- ☐ **Supervise children at all times in all areas of the pool.**
- ☐ **Inspect the pool site and equipment daily and alert Director to any potential safety.**
- ☐ **Vacuum pool liner and empty pool filters daily.**
- ☐ **Check pool water chemistry daily and adjust accordingly to maintain balanced levels.**
- ☐ **Assist with cleaning up pool areas and materials to ensure that all items are stored appropriately**
