Lifeguard

Lifeguards must be 16 years or older, have CPR/First Aid and Lifeguard

Certification. (training is NOT provided by the camp), demonstrate a professional demeanor and an excellent rapport with all families, work both independently and cooperatively with other staff members and above all to be punctual and prepared.

A lifeguard is expected to be a role model for all summer campers and pool patrons. Hours vary based on scheduling.

Job Responsibilities/Expectations include (but are not limited to)

Lifeguards are expected to maintain open, friendly and cooperative relationships with each child and family.

Supervise children at all times in all areas of the pool.

Inspect the pool site and equipment daily and alert Director to any potential safety.

Vacuum pool liner and empty pool filters daily.

Check pool water chemistry daily and adjust accordingly to maintain balanced levels.

Assist with cleaning up pool areas and materials to ensure that all items are stored appropriately
